3. Must be in attendance at an accredited graduate library program (MLIS) or have been recently admitted to an accredited library program.

4. Must be a resident of Manitoba.

5. Must submit a complete application by deadline:

- a. **Scholarship Application** form
- b. **Two letters of reference** using the MLA Scholarship Reference form. Letters must be submitted directly from the references.
- c. **A one page personal statement** including at a minimum; career goals, leadership potential, details of learning timeline if enrolled in distance education or part-time program and intention to work in Manitoba upon graduation.
- d. Current and complete **resume**.
- e. **Official undergraduate or graduate** (if applicable) **academic transcripts** sent directly from the University or submitted via applicant in University-sealed/stamped envelope (copies may be permitted - contact awards@mla.mb.ca to inquire).
- f. If applicable, **letter of admittance** from ALA-accredited MLIS program.
